In fact, according to the ASER (Rural) report during the pandemic, children (aged 6-14 years) who are not currently enrolled in schools increased from [2.5 percent in 2018 to 4.6 percent in 2021](#).

Underprivileged children lose their ability to have a normal childhood. They aren't capable of developing emotionally, physically, and socially. Moreover, research has shown that they are more likely to be depressed, have low self-esteem, not receive an education, and suffer from a lack of sleep and bad nutrition. As these children grow up, they are less likely to positively contribute to society since they might not be able to hold a stable and well-paying job. Instead of working, they are more likely to partake in crime and fall victim to the criminal justice system. This is where [education donation](#) comes in, as it can help provide underprivileged children with the opportunity to learn and grow. Children are the nation's future. Without them, the world would go nowhere.

Government Commerce College believes that the power to better the lives of others, is considered a privilege. It comes with a feeling of contentment and gratitude. Dear Sir/Madam,

As you may recall, prior to the onset of the pandemic and the lockdown, KCG had released the results of the 'Gujarat State Institutional Rating Framework' (GSIRF) 2020 on February 21 2020. The second edition of GSIRF has noticed a positive development with several participating institutions climbing up the ratings as well as showcasing progress in the recently released 'National Institutional Ranking Framework' (NIRF) 2020.

From the first edition, we also see a marked improvement in the participation and feedback from institutions. 28 Universities, 68 Colleges, 22 Engineering & a dozen plus institutions in the areas of Pharmacy, Law, Architecture & Management participated in GSIRF 2020. Gujarat University, CEPT University and Nirma University have excelled with a 5 Star in the categories of University, Architecture and Pharmacy respectively. ISTAR, Gujarat National Law University and SR Luthra have each achieved top spots on Engineering, Law and Management respectively. Colleges that have stood out with their performance are: St Xaviers, Sir PT Sarvajani, Mafatlal Gagalbhai and Shree Manibhai Virani Science.

Akin to NIRF, the parameters of GSIRF are similar, except for the differentiation between Rankings & Ratings. The exercise is independently conducted by an established third party agency, the Indian Centre for Academic Rankings & Excellence (ICARE) and a detailed data collation exercise is undertaken by them whilst ensuring a comprehensive, an objective and a transparent evaluation exercise.
